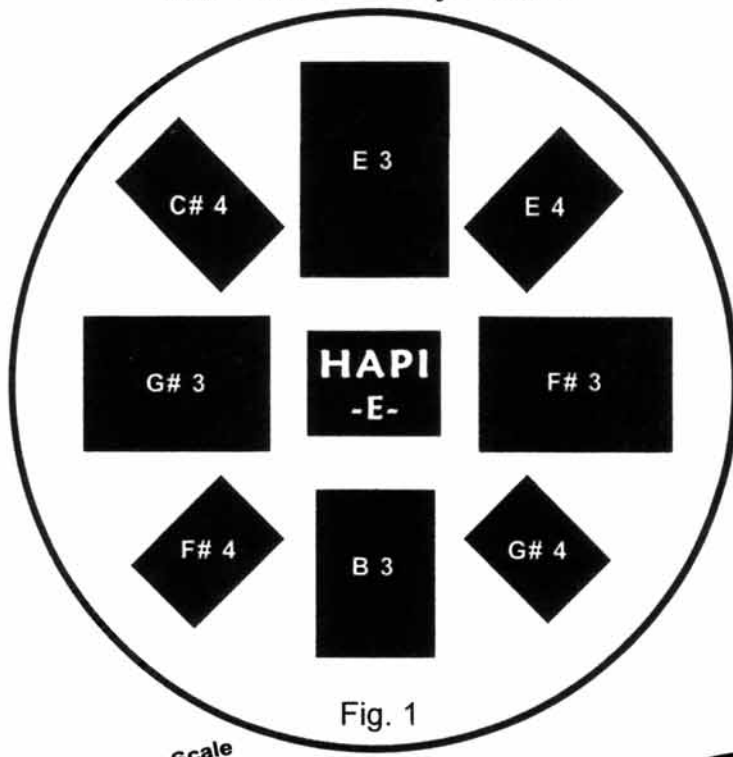

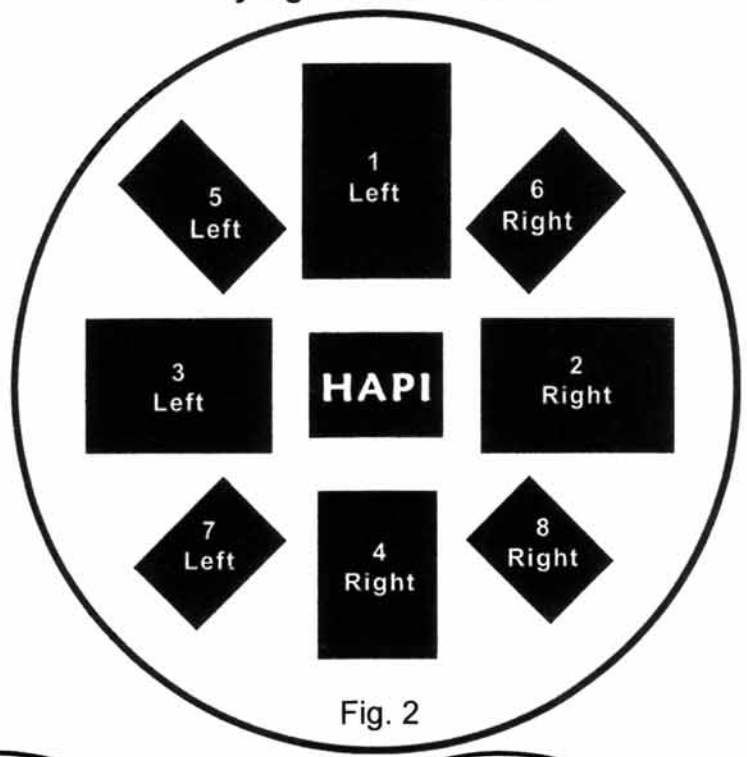

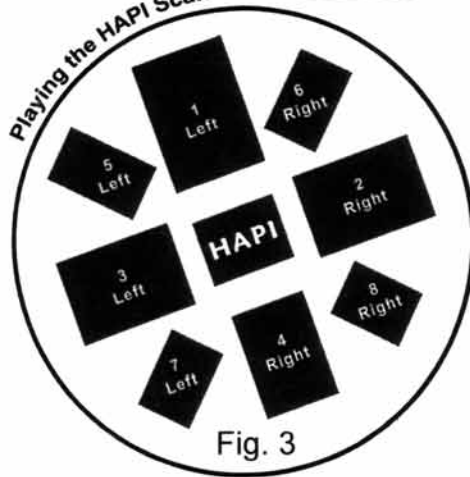
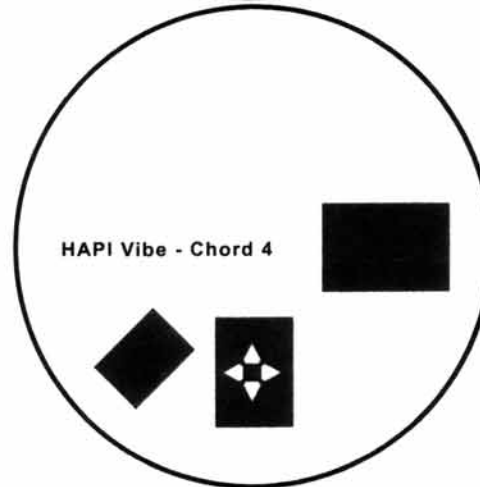
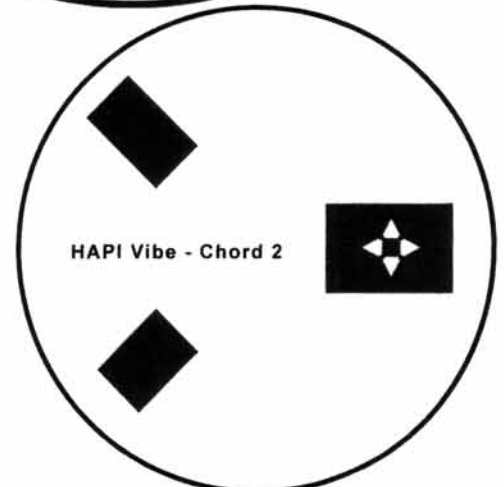
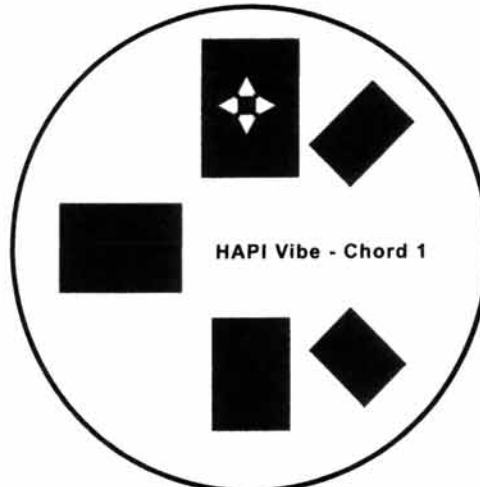

Chord playing. The 5 diagrams above show recommended chords for each of the first five notes. Notes 6, 7, and 8 are octave repeats of 1, 2, and 3 (see fig. 2). They will share the same chords as their lower octave. While these are recommended chords based on musical thirds and fifths you will find many other note combos that sound great. You can play each chord with all the notes struck at once or in any consecutive order you like. But, don't limit yourself to chords as the pentatonic scale will allow you to play any note combination and still sound great!
